

ACTIONS DURING AN ARMED ATTACK

RHF+

You have stopped the threat and used your weapon. What now?



SECURE YOUR WEAPON

- Do not hold the weapon in your hands. Place it into the holster, or put it on the ground.
- Do not touch the weapon unless a police officer gives you a direct instruction to do so.



INFORM

- Call 158 to reach the emergency line of the Police of the Czech Republic.
- State your first and last name, and briefly explain what happened.
- When answering questions, avoid long explanations.
- Give the precise location of the incident. Describe the place (floor, apartment number etc.) and describe your clothing in detail (colour, patterns, etc.).
- State whether you used your weapon.
- Describe the condition of the attacker and all the other persons involved.
- Follow the operator's instructions and stay on the line.



COOPERATE

(The police are already on scene)

- Keep your hands visible, stay calm, and avoid sudden movements. Do not run, do not make abrupt or excessive gestures.
- Cooperate with the police officers, follow their commands and instructions, and do not argue.
- Be prepared for officers to apply safety measures for their protection (disarming, ordering you to lie on the ground, handcuffing).
- Police officers may issue commands such as: "Put the weapon on the ground!", "Lie on the ground!", "Keep your hands visible!" Follow all commands without delay.
- Answer the questions and inform police officers if you are injured.



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
