

ACTIONS DURING AN ARMED ATTACK

IN CASE A FIRE BREAKS OUT

During an armed attack, a fire may occur. In such a situation, act according to the Fight, Flight, Freeze principle. The situation may be complicated by high temperatures and dangerous combustion products.

If possible:

RUN



- Escape from the smoke filled area (leave the building or move to another room).
- Protect your respiratory system by covering your mouth and nose with cloth (a scarf, clothes).
- Move as close to the floor as possible, where there is usually less smoke and the air is cleaner.

If you cannot escape:

HIDE



- Close and barricade the door.
- Limit smoke entering the room by sealing gaps under the door with cloth.
- Find a window. If it is safe, open it and hang a piece of cloth from it so rescuers can identify your location.
- Report your location by calling **112 or 158**.



If you have no other option:

FIGHT

only as a last resort.
