Car driving course Brno

Six members of the Rapid Response Unit of the Czech Police took part in the five-day course. The course was designed as theoretical preparation (20%) and 80% was devoted to practical exercises.

Each set of information from the theoretical part was immediately applied and translated into abilities and skills in the practical part. Practical training took the form of repeating individual skills. Emphasis was placed both on the use of the correct technique and on getting acquainted with the reaction of the vehicle when using the incorrect technique or in the case of chaotic and uncoordinated movement of the vehicle. Thanks to this, the course participants gained a comprehensive idea of the vehicle's response to a wide range of situations that may occur in traffic and, in particular, gained confidence in solving them. Exercises were set for a wide range of speeds from low to very high. Part of the practical training took place on the racing circuit in Brno, where the course participants gained confidence in controlling the vehicle and solving unexpected situations at very high speeds. Throughout the course, participants were accommodated in a hotel on the premises of the Brno circuit, i.e. in the immediate vicinity of the training ground and the race circuit, which resulted in the most efficient use of teaching time without unnecessary losses during transfers.
