

Seminar "Education in the field of intercultural competences and minority specifics"

29. 11. 2022

On **November 29, 2022**, as part of the PDP1 project "Crime prevention not only in socially excluded localities", the planned seminar "**New ways of migration and their strategies from the countries of the Middle East**" took place at the Spiritka facility in Prague 6.

The project is based on task No. 63 of the Crime Prevention Action Plan for the years 2016 - 2020 "Provide education in the field of crime prevention with a focus on preventive action in socially excluded localities and localities at risk of social exclusion". It is also based on the Strategy for the Work of the Police of the Czech Republic in Relation to Minorities.

A sensitive issue is the contact of members of the security force with members of other national cultures. The rights of national minorities are today understood as an integral part of human rights. As some minority communities are considered to be particularly vulnerable groups, it is appropriate to pay due attention to knowledge of minority rights and minority specifics.

The seminar was attended by 53 listeners, mainly from the Police of the Czech Republic. The participants were introduced to the topics of migration and its new trends through university study programs, all based on the lecturer's practical experience. The speaker also talked about the employment of these "students" in the Czech Republic and their possible further migration to Europe. A colleague from Slovakia (Police Presidium Bratislava) also took part in the seminar.

The seminar capacity of 65 people was not completely filled due to the capacity of the lecture hall. These seminars will continue. Due to the great interest in this topic, it is possible to extend it to other areas as well.
